24 PROPOSED BOND ISSUES AND TAX LEVY

**MIAMI VALLEY CAREER TECHNOLOGY
VOCATIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT**

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

24 1. Shall bonds be issued by the Miami Valley Career Technology Vocational School District to pay the local share of school construction under the State of Ohio Vocational Facilities Assistance Program in the principal amount of \$34,357,734 to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 30 years, and an annual levy of property taxes to be made outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the repayment period of the bond issue 0.29 mill for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to (\$0.029) for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2017, first due in calendar year 2018, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

2. Shall bonds be issued by the Miami Valley Career Technology Vocational School District for the purpose of paying for improvements to facilities, including renovations, additions, equipment, technology, furnishings and site improvements, and all necessary appurtenances thereto in the principal amount of \$95,490,959 to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 30 years, and an annual levy of property taxes to be made outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the repayment period of the bond issue 0.8 mill for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to (\$0.080) for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2017, first due in calendar year 2018, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

3. Levy an additional tax for the benefit of the Miami Valley Career Technology Vocational School District for the purpose of enlarging, improving, rebuilding, erecting, and equipping of buildings including maintenance of classroom facilities at a rate not exceeding 0.34 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to (\$0.034) for each one hundred dollars of valuation for a period of ten (10) years, commencing in 2017, first due in calendar year 2018.
